A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay William H. Morgan, Tax Collector for Harford county, for overpayment into the Treasury for the years 1862 and 1863.

A bill entitled an Act for the relief of Richard S. Mercer, and to pay to Peter W. Crain and N. C. Stephen, assignees in bankruptcy of Thomas F. Bowie, a sum of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury by Thomas F. Bowie on account of storage on tobacco.
