Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Corporation of Bladensburg, in Prince George's county, passed March 9th, 1854.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Prince George's, Carroll and Somerset counties.

A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of James Bullock.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled an Act to prohibit stock from running at large in and around Pikesville, in Baltimore county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Baltimore, Anne Arundel and Frederick counties.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 10, chapter 299, of the Acts of 1868, entitled "Public Roads," so far as the same may relate to Talbot county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Talbot, Frederick and St. Mary's counties.

A bill entitled an Act to enable Peter Leatherman and George Leatherman to sell a certain piece of property belonging to the Tunker Church, near Wolfsville, in Frederick county.
