

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall only apply to the counties of Caroline, Kent, Talbot, Frederick, Prince George's, Queen Anne's, Charles and Harford.

Which was read and adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.
