A bill entitled an Act to amend the Act of 1868, chapter 253, entitled an Act to remove cases of guardianship from Somerset and Worcester counties to Wicomico county,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled an Act for the relief of John B. Magruder, late Inspector of Tobacco, Warehouse No. 1, and of persons employed under him in said Warehouse,

Endorsed, "Reported favorably from the Committee on Claims, read a second time and under provisions of the Constitution, section 27, Article 3, a third time and passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled an Act to increase the number of incorporators in an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Westernport and Potomac Railroad Company, passed at the January session in 1853, chapter 219,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Salisbury Gas Light Company,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendment."
