given and declared to the said gift and bequest of the said Andrew Small, and to the said sale of lands made by the said Richard M. Williams, trustee as aforesaid.

In force.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 14.

AN ACT to refund Alexander Brown and Sons, of the city of Baltimore, agents of Brown, Shipley and Company, of London, the sum of fifty-eight pounds, sixteen shillings and ten pence, in gold, amounting in currency to four hundred dollars and ninety cents, for money erroneously paid by them into the Treasury on or about the 1st July, 1867.

Comptroller to pay.

In force.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer, to pay to Alexander Brown & Sons, of the city of Baltimore, agents of Brown, Shipley & Co., the said sum of four hundred dollars and ninety cents, (\$400.90) out of any unappropriated funds in the Treasury.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
