Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

### CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to repeal one hundred and seventy-fourth Section of Article four, of the Public Local Laws, relating to the city of Baltimore, and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section one hundred and seventy-four of Article four, of the Public Local Laws, be repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows : Repealed.

Sec. 174. The regular terms for the sitting of the Circuit Court of Baltimore City, shall be on the second Monday of May, the second Monday of September, the second Monday of November, the second Monday of January, and the second Monday of March, in each year, and the second Monday of July in each year shall be a return day. Terms changed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.

### CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT to amend an Act passed at the January Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, Chapter two hundred and seventy-six, entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Maryland Mutual Life and Fire Insurance Company, by changing the corporate name thereof: "

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the corporate name and title of the said corporation be and the same is hereby Title altered.
