CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT to repeal the first Section of the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Chapter fifty, relating to the County Commissioners of Wicomico County, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Three Commissioners.

Power.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section one of the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Chapter fifty, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows: There shall be three County Commissioners for Wicomico County, who shall have and exercise all the powers and duties of the County Commissioners in the several Counties of the State, including the power of appointing three trustees of the poor in said County.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the present Board of County Commissioners of Wicomico County shall be and remain in office during the Remain in whole term for which they were elected, with all office. the powers conferred by the first Section of this Act.

In force.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
