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CHAPTER 124.

AN ACT to direct the Comptroller to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay to George Colton & Son the sum of twenty-four hundred ninety-five dollars and forty-seven cents.

Treasurer to pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay to George Colton & Son the sum of twenty-four hundred ninety-five dollars and forty-seven cents, which said sum is in full for furnishing papers, printing and binding three thousand copies of the School Report in January, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, by order of Governor Bowie, in accordance with the Act of Assembly of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Chapter four hundred and seven.

In force. Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from and after the day of its passage.

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CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT to amend the Act of January Session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, Chapter two hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Baltimore Warehouse Company."
