

CHAPTER 130.

AN ACT to amend an Act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Emmittsburg Railroad Company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all subscribers and shareholders to the capital stock of the Emmittsburg Railroad Company shall have authority to vote at all elections; *provided,* such subscribers or shareholders shall not be indebted to the Company for any indebtedness actually due on account of any calls upon their shares, at the time of so offering to vote. To Vote.  
Proviso.

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That all elections, for which provision is made under the charter of said Company, may be held at any time after that fixed for the same by the charter; *provided,* at least ten days notice of the time and place for holding the same shall have been given through some paper published in Frederick County. Election.  
Notice of.

Sec. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 131.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of an additional Justice of the Peace in District number two, (Hall's Cross Roads,) in Harford County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That in addition to the four Justices of the Peace in District number two, in Harford County, now provided for by law, there shall be one additional Justice of the Peace appointed for said District, in said county, and the Governor is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint and commission one additional Justice of the Peace for said District. Additional

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
