Sec. 21. And be it enacted, That the judges and clerk of election shall notify the persons elected of clerk. their election, and the persons so elected shall severally hold their respective offices from the first Saturday of April in each and every year next ensuing the election for and during one year and until their successors shall be duly elected and qualified as required by this Charter.

Sec. 22. And be it enacted, That the Magistrate of the town of Manchester when incorporated shall appoint. have power to appoint three judges, who shall give legal notice as specified in this Charter to call the first meeting for holding the first election under this Charter of the eligible citizens of the town of Manchester, and said judges shall also appoint a clerk or clerks who shall keep a correct record of said meetings.
