ested may inspect without charge. And if any one shall feel aggrieved at the valuation and assessment Assessment. of his, her or their property by said assessors, he, she or they may appeal from such valuation to the Commissioners at any time within two weeks from the return of the said assessment, and upon good cause being shown, the said Commissioners may make any alteration in said assessment which they may deem proper and right; and for the purpose of hearing and determining the appeals pro- Hear appeals. vided for by this section, the said Commissioners, in addition to the meetings hereinbefore required to be held, shall meet daily, Sundays excepted, during the two weeks next succeeding the thirtieth day of June, in each and every year, at such time and place as they shall designate, and shall give five days previous notice thereof, by advertisement, Give notice. to be posted at the Hotel and the Academy, in said village, and such other public places as they may deem necessary.

114. The said Commissioners shall have full power to open, extend, widen, close or straighten May open and any street, lane or alley in said village which in widen streets. their judgment the public welfare and convenience may require.

115. The said Commissioners may levy upon the assessable property within said village by direct to defray extax, not exceeding fifty cents in the hundred dol- penses. lars, such sum as they may deem necessary for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said corporation, and of opening, closing, extending and improving the streets, lanes or alleys in said village, and of building, repairing or improving the public wells and pumps and fire engines belonging to said corporation, in such manner as they may deem expedient, with full power to collect the same, as is hereinafter provided.

Power to

116. The said Commissioners shall, as soon after the expiration of the time for hearing appeals as practicable, proceed to ascertain the amount necessary to be levied for the use of the said corpora- ation. tion and the rate of taxation, and shall cause to be made and delivered to the Bailiff a book containing an alphabetical list of the tax-payers in said village, together with the aggregate assess- payers.
