

Capital extended however acquired. and dispose of all property, real, personal and mixed, and fee simple and leasehold, not exceeding in amount one hundred thousand dollars, as may be acquired by gift, grant, purchase, devise, or bequest, to aid and enable the said Maryland Baptist Union Association to carry out and perform the objects for which it is incorporated.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 154.

AN ACT to repeal Sections one hundred and one, one hundred and two, one hundred and five, and one hundred and forty-five, of Article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, relating to the powers and duties of the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections one hundred and one, one hundred and two, one hundred and five, and one hundred and forty-five, of Article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, of Frederick County, relating to the powers and duties of the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, be, and the same, are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments as follows:

Additional Constables. Salary. 101. They may provide by ordinance for the appointment of one or more Constables, who shall, within the police limits of the Corporation, have all the powers possessed by Constables in this State, except as to the collection of debts, and the said Constables shall receive a salary to be fixed by ordinance annually, and shall not be entitled to receive any fees, costs or other emoluments.

102. All officers of the Corporation not herein named, who shall be deemed necessary to execute the laws and ordinances of the Corporation, shall
