

CHAPTER 168.

AN ACT entitled an additional Supplement to An Act to Incorporate the Roman Catholic Congregation in Baltimore Town, passed November Session, seventeen hundred and ninety-five, chapter fifteen, to enable the said Corporation to purchase a new Burial Ground.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Trustees of the Catholic Cathedral Church of Baltimore, and their successors, as incorporated by the Act of eighteen hundred and twenty, chapter eighty-four, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in addition to the ground and premises which the said Corporation was authorized to purchase and use as a Burial Ground by the Act of eighteen hundred and fourteen, chapter two, and eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter three hundred and eighty-four, to purchase, hold and use for a Burial Ground attached to said church and lands and premises in Baltimore County, not exceeding one hundred acres. Purchase and hold.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 169.

AN ACT to repeal Section seventeen, Article fifty-three, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Landlord and Tenant," as repealed and re-enacted by Chapter one hundred and seventy-three of the Acts passed eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, exempting certain articles from distress for rent, and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section seventeen, Article fifty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, enti-
