terested persons to view and ascertain the damages by him sustained, and they or a majority of them shall certify the same under their hands and seals to the County Commissioners of the county wherein the said injury or killing took place, and the said County Commissioners shall provide for the payment of the same, together with the costs attending the said appraisement out of the fund aforesaid, if there be so much, or as soon as there shall be sufficient in their hands to enable them to do so.

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That any money in the hands of the County Commissioners of either of said counties, at the end of any year from the levy thereof, over and above the amount required for the carrying out the provisions of this Act, shall be by the said County Commissioners of the county be by the said County Commissioners of the county wherein the said surplus may exist, paid over to surplus. the Board of County School Commissioners for said county, to be by them applied to the purposes of education; provided, the said fund shall never thereby be decreased below the minimum of five creased. hundred dollars.

And be it enacted, That any dog kept or straying about any house shall be deemed sufficient evidence of ownership, to authorize the Ownership deconstable to return the person inhabiting said house as the owner or keeper thereof, and every dog not returned shall be deemed to have no owner or keeper, and it shall be the duty of the constable to kill said dog, for which he shall receive a fee, as provided for in Section four of this kill. Act.

Sec. 9. And be it enacted, That if any dog shall be seen running sheep, any person may kill him, or if any dog shall be known to worry sheep, and information thereof be given to the owner or sheep. keeper thereof, if he does not kill said dog, he shall make full compensation for all damages done Compensation by it, and any person seeing the dog running at large may kill him.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That the bonds now required by law to be given by Constables, shall be liable for all moneys collected by them under this Act, and not paid over, as aforesaid, to be collected in the name of the County Commissioners
