

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted*, That if any person or persons shall haul or fish with any seine or seines over one hundred fathoms in length, in Synapuxent Bay or its tributaries, or in any of the bays or their tributaries, on the eastern side of Worcester County above the line of Virginia, he or they shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, for the first offence, and two hundred dollars for every subsequent offence, with all costs accruing in the prosecution of such offender or offenders. Penalty.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Cecil County to build or repair certain public buildings in said County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Cecil County be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to build a new County Jail for said county, or to repair or rebuild the old one, and to repair or remodel the present Court House for said county. To repair or build a jail.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of said county are hereby authorized to issue proposals and make contracts for repairing or rebuilding said old Jail, or for the building of a new one, as they may deem most proper, and to repair or remodel the present Court House, and to make such levy or levies on the assessable property of said county as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act. May remodel.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said County Commissioners of Cecil County are hereby authorized, if in their discretion they deem it proper, to sell and convey the present Jail property in the town of Elkton, and to purchase other lands for the use of said county, on which to build a new Jail and the necessary out-buildings. Sell and convey or to purchase.
