Sec. 12. And be it enacted, That the provisions of this Act, so far as may be applicable in their Applicable to privileges and restrictions to any and all banks now existing under charter from the General Assembly of Maryland, may be availed of by said bank or banks.

Suspend business.

Sec. 13. And be it enacted, That if the President and Directors should at any time suspend the active business operations or workings of any banking institutution incorporated under this Act, other than as how legally provided for, and a majority of the stockholders in general meeting assembled determine to close its banking operations, thenceforth it shall not be lawful for such corporation to resume the exercise of its banking powers and franchises, but the same shall be closed, and after the payment of its debts and liabilities the remaining assets and property of such corporations shall be divided among the stockholders or their assigns.

Resume.

Inconsistent.

Sec. 14. And be it enacted, That any and all Acts or parts of Act or Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be and are hereby repealed.

In force.

Sec. 15. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and continue in force until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty-five, and to the end of the next session of the General Assembly thereafter.

CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of sixty-nine thousand two hundred and ninety-six dollars and twenty-eight cents, to pay the various mechanics and others the amounts due them for work and labor done, and materials furnished, in the erection of the Governor's Mansion, at Annapolis, and the enclosure and improvement of the grounds surrounding the same.
