enacted for the protection of cemeteries, burial grounds and places of sepulchre, shall apply with full force and effect to this Cemetery hereby incorporated, immediately from and after the passage of this Act.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That the sum of five thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to carry into effect this Act, which amount shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Corporation upon the warrant of the Governor, in such sums as may be by him deemed necessary. Before any money is paid [is paid], it shall be the duty of the Trustees to select a site for the Cemetery, in accordance with this Act, to report the same to the Governor for his approval, stating the price to be paid, and the location, and such other information as the Governor may require.
