Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to give to the said Company any banking privileges, and the General Not to issue. Assembly hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal the charter hereby created, and that nothing contained in this Act shall authorize the said Company to erect their gas works or manu- Limits. facturing within two hundred yards of the Main street of Snow Hill Town.

Sec. 11. And be it enacted, That this Act shall In force. take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 215.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for transcribing, indexing, re-binding Records, preservpapers, and for preparing a digest of the laws, and rules of the Land Office.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of four thousand dollars be appropriated for the purpose of transcrib- Appropriated. ing, re-binding, indexing records, preserving papers in the Chancery and Land Office, as required for their preservation, transcribing, re-binding and indexing.
