

Injure or
destroy.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That if any person shall wilfully injure or destroy any part of said Railway, or any building, vehicle, or other property of said Company, or shall wilfully obstruct the free passage of any car or other vehicle on said Railway, he or she shall be subject to a penalty of twenty dollars, to be collected as other fines are collected.

Not to stand
on road.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said Company shall not permit any car or other vehicle to stand on said Railway, except for a reasonable time to receive and discharge passengers, produce or merchandise.

Extend rail-
way.

Restrictions.

Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the said President, Managers and Company be authorized to extend their said Railway to such points in the city of Baltimore, and to connect with such of the railways in said city, or which may be constructed therein, as the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall permit, direct and ordain, and subject to such restrictions, terms and conditions as said Mayor and City Council may prescribe and impose, and as the Baltimore City Passenger Railway Company shall consent and agree to.

Amend.

In force.

Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this charter at its pleasure, and that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT to repeal Section six of Article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Billiards."
