

CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT to authorize the appointment of two additional Justices of the Peace for Dorchester county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That in addition to the two Justices of the Peace in the first election district of Dorchester county, as now provided for by law, there shall be an additional Justice of the Peace appointed for said district in Dorchester county, and also an additional Justice of the Peace in the fifth election district of said county, and the Governor is hereby authorized to appoint and commission two additional Justices of the Peace for said districts.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Section. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, who is hereby authorized and directed to issue the same, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to John Murphy & Co., seven thousand five hundred and four dollars and seventy-six cents for stationery and books furnished the State Library for the General Assembly
