forty-six thousand four hundred and seventy dollars, (\$46,470,) and the State's common stock in the main stem of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, amounting to five hundred thousand dollars, (\$500,000,) the same to be disposed of in the order above named, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of paying and can-celling so many of the said bonds of this State already due and to become due in the year eighteen hundred and seventy, as the holders thereof may require to be paid, and who may refuse to accept new and substituted bonds therefor, as hereinbefore provided, and the Comptroller is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer, who thereupon is authorized to pay to the holders so demanding payment, the amounts of such bonds upon which payment may be demanded.

Old bonds to be cancelled.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That upon the issue of any new bond, according to the provisions of the first section of this Act, the Treasurer, in the presence of the Comptroller, shall cancel the corresponding old bond, and after making proper entry thereof, in a book to be kept for that purpose, he shall, in the presence of the Governor and Comptroller, destroy the old bond for which any new bond has been substituted.

In force.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
