CHAPTER 314.

AN ACT to add additional sections to Article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, relating to the powers and duties of the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to follow Section one hundred and sixty-nine, added thereto by the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Chapter eighty-seven.

Addition.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sections be added to Article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, relating to the powers and duties of the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to follow Section one hundred and sixty-nine, added thereto by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter eighty-seven:

Powers of

170. The Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick shall have full power and authority to open, widen, deepen and straighten the channel of Carroll creek whenever they may deem it advisable, expedient or necessary, within the police limits of Frederick City, so as to prevent any part of Frederick from being inundated by floods in said creek, and to purchase all such real estate as may be necessary for such purpose, and receive deeds for the same.

That in case the said Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick and the owner or owners of the real estate wanted for the purpose of opening, widening, deepening or straightening said creek, cannot agree upon the price of such real estate, or in case the owner or owners of the same, or any of
