CHAPTER 332.

AN ACT to repeal Sections one hundred and ninety-four, one hundred and ninety-six, and one hundred and ninety-seven, of Chapter thirty-five, of Article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Docks, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections one hundred and ninety-four, one hundred and ninety-six and one hundred and ninety-seven, of Chapter thirty-five of Article four of the Code of Public Local Laws of this State, be and the same are hereby repealed, and re-enacted to read as follows :

Sec. 194. *And be it enacted*, If any vessel shall be lying in Smith's Dock, Frederick Street Dock, or any other private dock in said city, or the entrance thereof, so as to obstruct any vessel which shall be coming into the same, or moving from one place to another therein, or going out of the same, the vessel so obstructing, unless when *bona fide* loading or unloading, shall be removed to such place as shall be directed by the harbor master of the district, to give room to the passing vessel, under the penalty of five dollars for refusal so to remove, and at the rate of five dollars an hour for the delay which shall be occasioned to the passing vessel, to be paid by the master or owner of the
