AN ACT to repeal the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Chapter sixty-three, "An Act to provide for the appointment of four Superintendents to supervise and control the repairs and improvements of three public country roads in Allegany County-one leading from Oakland to Accident, one leading from Accident to the National Road at some point west of Grantsville, and one leading from a point on said road near McHenry's gate to Selbysport, in said county, and to authorize the County Commissioners of said county to make levies for the repairs and improvements of the same."
