CHAPTER 353.

AN ACT to amend an Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Chapter two hundred and thirty-eight, entitled, Licenses, so as to empower traders to sell the license with the stock of goods.

Sell license.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That when any trader shall sell and dispose of his goods, wares and merchandise, and at the same time shall sell his license to the person or persons purchasing said goods, wares and merchandise, the purchase and transfer of said license shall be entered by the Clerk of the Circuit Court where such license was obtained, and the Clerk's fee for said service shall be fifty cents.
