CHAPTER 419.

AN ACT to repeal Section two of Chapter four hundred and thirty-four of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An Act to grant Donations to Wicomico County, for the use of Academics and Schools," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section two of Chapter four hundred and thirty-four of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed January session Repealed and eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an Act to grant donations to Wicomico County, for the use of academies and schools, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as fol-

lows:

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, shall pay annually, on the first Monday in April, to the Trustees of Fairmount Academy, in Somerset County, the sum of four hundred dollars, which Treasurer to said sum shall be inclusive of the appropriation of two hundred dollars heretofore donated to said Academy in Section two of said Act.

CHAPTER 420.
