Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the fourth Section of the Act Repealed and passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, Chapter thirty-seven, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Mutual Insurance Campany of Washington County," be, and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows: The Board of Directors of the Mutual Insurance Company of Washington County, shall have full power and authority to elect the officers named, to fix their salaries, to approve the bonds required from such officers, and to prescribe the penalties thereof; and the said Company are hereby invested with all the powers requisite and proper to carry this Act into effect, and in case any vacancy or vacancies shall occur in the Board of Directors from death, resignation or otherwise, the Board of Directors shall supply such vacancy or vacancies until the next annual election.
