

Sec. 10. *And be it enacted*, That Sections two, three, four, eight and eleven, of the original Act of Incorporation of said company, be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other parts of said original Act inconsistent herewith are also repealed, but all parts of said original Act not inconsistent herewith are continued in force; *provided, however*, that this Act shall not take effect until the same shall have been accepted by the holders of more than half the whole number of shares of stock of the said Washington Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, and when so accepted this Act, and the said original Act to which this is a supplement as hereby modified, shall constitute the charter of said corporation.

CHAPTER 441.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Article thirty-eight, Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," by repealing and re-enacting the same with an amendment.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section one of Article thirty-eight, Code of Public General Laws, under title "Fees of Officers," be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following is hereby enacted in lieu thereof:

1. All accounts for officers' fees shall be made out in a fair and clear manner, and in words at length; and whenever any person interested in them, or to whom the same shall be charged, shall require a copy of such account, the several officers herein named shall, in as short a time as may be convenient, give him an account of said charges in words at length; and no account for officers' fees by any of the several officers herein named, rendered for services to or in behalf of any county of this State, shall be allowed by the County Commissioners thereof, until said account has been
