

Sec. 10. *And be it enacted*, That there shall be paid on every share of such stock two dollars at the time of subscribing or organizing of said corporation, and the residue of the subscription shall be paid whenever assessed or called for by the Board of Directors, by giving thirty days' notice ; upon default in the payment of any sum due on subscriptions, the stock may be forfeited and sold for the payment thereof, under such regulations as the by-laws shall prescribe, or the corporation may by suit recover the same from the holder of the stock at the time of the assessment thereof.

Installments.

Give notice.

Sec. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation shall have authority to construct, maintain and work the railroad mentioned in the first section of this Act, and branches or lateral railroads from its main line, not exceeding five miles in length.

Construct and work.

Sec. 12. *And be it enacted*, That for transportation on its railroads and branches, or any part thereof, the said corporation shall have a right to charge and collect as toll and transportation charges, at rates not exceeding six cents per ton of property, or four cents per passenger for each mile of transportation, but for any distance, twenty-five cents may be charged for a passenger or for any quantity of freight.

Rate of charge

Sec. 13. *And be it enacted*, That the said Railroad and branches may be constructed with as many sets of tracks as the corporation shall deem proper ; and the corporation may construct and maintain all bridges and other structures and works which it shall deem necessary for the purpose of its corporation ; but the land which it shall have a right to acquire for the construction of such road branches and works, shall not exceed sixty-six feet in width, besides the necessary spaces for slopes along the main line or any branch generally, and five acres at either terminus of the main line or a branch, and one acre at any intermediate station.

Tracks.

Acquire land.

Sec. 14. *And be it enacted*, That if the corporation cannot agree with the owner for the purchase, use or occupation of lands, gravel, earth, timber, or other material required for the construction,
