AN ACT to Incorporate the Hope Mutual Life Insurance Company of Maryland. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly

of Maryland, That George F. Needham, George N. Mackenzie, William B. Canfield, Ezra Whitman, E. Otis Hinkley, John Curlett, Gerard H. Reese, F. H. Grupy, John F. Wiley, William H. Richardson, Ed. T. Norris, John B. Brown, Samuel R. Smith, and all other persons who may hereafter associate with them, in the manner hereinafter prescribed, shall be, and are hereby declared a body politic and corporate, by the name of "The Hope Mutual Life Insurance Company of Maryland," and by that name may contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, defend and be defended against, in any and all Courts.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this corporation shall have no powers or privileges, except such as are expressly granted by this charter.
