St. Mary's Orphan Asylum, four hundred dollars; to the Union Orphan's Asylum, four hundred dollars; to the Maryland Institute for Promotion of Mechanic Arts, three thousand dollars; to the Manual Labor School, four hundred dollars; and to the Home for Friendless Children on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, to be erected at or near Easton, five thousand dollars.

PUBLIC DERT. '

For the payment of the interest on the public debt of this State, that is to say, the interest fall- Public debt. ing due quarterly on the currency debt, the interest on the bounty loan outstanding, and the interest on the sterling debt falling due semi-annually and payable in London, including the cost of exchange, remittance and commissions, eight hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars; for the payment of the interest on the bonds of the Annapolis and Elk Ridge Railroad Company, issued in eighdred and forty-six and eighteen hundred and sixtyfour, five hundred and thirty dollars.

To the night watchman of the public buildings, six hundred dollars; to the person employed to Miscellaneous. take care of the public buildings, five hundred and forty dollars; to the keeper of the steam house and Record Office furnace, five hundred and forty dollars; to the assistant seeper of the steam house and Record Office furnace, five hundred and forty dollars; to the person employed to attend to the rooms of the Court of Appeals, one hundred dollars; to a messenger for the Governor, seven hundred dollars; for the salary of the State Vaccine Agent, six hundred dollars; for the expense of distributing the Maryland Reports, fifty dollars; for repairing the roof of the State House, five hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of Augustus Gassaway, Secretary of the Senate; for repairs and painting of the interior of the State House, to be expended under the direction of Augustus Gassaway, Secretary to the Senate, fifteen hundred dollars; for completing a bronze statue of Chief Justice Taney, to be erected in front of the State House, in addition to the appropriation contained in the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven,
