

Proviso. thereon of a stable and carriage house for the executive mansion in Annapolis; *provided*, that no part of the money hereby appropriated shall be paid to the said Black until the Attorney General shall have certified to the Comptroller that he has made an examination of the title of said property, and has found the same property vested in the State.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 466.

AN ACT to distribute the Academic and High School Fund of Carroll County to the Western Maryland College and Manchester Academy, in Carroll County.

Preamble. WHEREAS, There appears to be in the treasury, and due to the said county for Academic and High School purpose, for the years eighteen hundred and sixty-eight and eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, the sum of twenty-four hundred dollars; therefore,

Comptroller to issue warrant on Treasurer. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer in favor of the Board of Trustees of the Western Maryland College for the sum of twenty-one hundred and eighty dollars, of the sum due for the years eighteen hundred and sixty-eight and eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, and to the Board of Trustees of the said Manchester Academy, the sum of two hundred and twenty dollars of the sum due for the same years, and in each and every year thereafter to pay to the said trustees of the Western Maryland College, the sum of one thousand and ninety dollars, and to the said Board of Trustees of the said Manchester Academy, the sum of one hundred and ten dollars, said payments to be made on the first day of April in each and every year.
