Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Western Maryland College shall receive and give tuition, Free tuition. free of charge, to at least one scholar from each election district in said county in each scholastic year, the said scholars to be appointed by the Board of School Commissioners of said county.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the said Manchester Academy shall receive and give tuition, Free tuition. free of charge, to at least one scholar in each scholastic year, the said scholar to be appointed as provided for in the preceding section.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act Repealed. be and the same are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That this Act shall In force. take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 467.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the present Trustees of the Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, or their successors, to receive and hold by conveyance from William Little, three acres of land in Cecil County, to be used as a Cemetery, and to hold the same in trust for said purpose.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Thomas J. Gillespie, Robert N. Hindman, William B. Rowland, James M. Trustees. Evans, George Gillespie, Theodore L. Marshall, Samuel Tosh, John W. Mount and James O. McCormick, Trustees of the Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church in Cecil County, or their successors, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase, and hold to them and their successors in office, a lot of ground in said county containing three acres, to appropriate and hold the same as a Cemetery, in trust for the use of Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church in said county.
