An act to repeal section nine hundred and thirty-nine, article four, of the Public Local Laws, relating to Baltimore city, sub-title "Water," as enacted by chapter four hundred and sixty-seven of the acts of Assembly passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and to re-enact the said section so as to read as follows..... 27
