Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to add an additional section to Article 4 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Aliens," and to be section 10 of said Article.

On motion of Mr. Myers,

Leave was granted to the Allegany delegation to report a bill to repeal an Act of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany county," sub-title "Fences," and re-enact the same with an amendment.

On motion of Mr. Martin,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill making an additional appropriation to pay for the iron steamer built by Wm. F. Shaw & Co., for the State Oyster Police Force.

On motion of Mr. Streett,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill to refund to Wm. H. Morgan, forty-two dollars and nineteen cents, amount of State tax paid in error.

On motion of Mr. Garey,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill to refund to Elijah Towers, Collector 3rd election district, Caroline county, a sum of money overpaid into the Treasury.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to report a bill to pay to Henry Brook, Clerk to the Circuit Court of Prince George's county, certain fees due him since 1868.
