

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Amend by inserting after the word "matter," in the 7th line of section 50, the following words :

And this section shall be construed to include all actions of debts for the collection of fines, penalties and forfeitures imposed by any law of the State, and which are made recoverable before a Justice of the Peace in which a right of appeal may not be given by the law imposing the same.

Amend by inserting after the word "appear," in the 8th line of section 50, the following words :

On or before the second day of the term of the Court to which such appeal is taken.
