The bill entitled an Act to refund to J. S. McCartney, of Hagerstown, Washington county, the sum of twenty-five dollars erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State.

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay John L. Smith, Tax Collector for Talbot county, for overpayment into the Treasury for the year 1867.

The bill entitled an Act to amend section 10, of Article 51, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Justices of the Peace."

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest or devise of Henry A. Stinnecke, late of Baltimore city, deceased, to the Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in Maryland.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace in the fifth election district of Baltimore county.

The bill entitled an Act supplemental to an Act to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, to convey a lot of ground to the Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore county, to be used for a Public School House site, passed 1868, chapter 393.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal 174th section of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws relating to the City of Baltimore, and re-enact the same with amendments.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal the first section of the Act of 1868, chapter 50, relating to the County Commissioners of Wicomico county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
