

Leave was granted to the Dorchester delegation to introduce a Bill changing the manner or mode of electing Trustees to Baptist Church property at Jones' Mills, Dorchester county.

Leave was granted to the Judiciary Committee to introduce a bill to repeal section 50, Article 5, of Public General Laws relating to appeals, and to re-enact the same as amended; and to add an additional section to said Article.

Leave was granted to the Judiciary Committee to introduce a bill to authorize the executors or administrators of non-resident stockholders to transfer the stock of their decedents in the Williamsport and Greencastle Turnpike Company, without taking out letters of administration or testamentary in this State.

Leave was granted to Harford delegation to introduce a bill to repeal chapter 183 of the Laws of Maryland, entitled an Act to repeal an Act to add a new section to Article 12 of the Code of Local Laws for Harford county, entitled schools, relating to the Harford county Academy and to the Cokesburg or Abingdon Academy; and to re-enact the same with an amendment dividing and changing the time of payment of the State's donation to Harford county Academy.
