The House proceeded to the consideration of the order of the day,

Being the bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 295, Act of Assembly, 1868, entitled an Act to amend Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Guano" by adding thereto the following section relating to the inspection of all fertilizers other than Guano, and to substitute the following in lieu thereof,
