The Senate bill entitled an Act to remedy and give effect to informal and invalid deeds and quiet possession thereunder.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize Joshua Motter and Samuel Motter, or either of them, to convey all the right, title, interest and claim of the German Reformed Congregation at Emmittsburg, in Frederick county, in and to the Elias Church property, to the Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, or their legal representatives.

Mr. Gatch, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to lay off streets in Baltimore county adjoining Baltimore city, and to repeal certain sections inconsistent therewith.
