

The bill entitled an Act to repeal Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, from sections 114 to 133, inclusive, title "Cecil county," sub-title, "North-East," and re-enact the same with amendments,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

A bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to an Act passed December session 1849, chapter 377, entitled an Act to incorporate a Company to make a Turnpike road from Williamsport, in Washington county, to the Pennsylvania line in the direction of Greencastle, in Franklin county, State of Pennsylvania.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed January session 1867, entitled an Act to authorize the Pennsylvania Horse Thief Detecting and Insurance Company, of York, Pennsylvania, to transact business in the State of Maryland, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

A bill entitled an Act to prevent fishing in Israel's creek, in Washington county.

A bill entitled an Act to empower the Commissioners of Wicomico county, to appoint an additional Constable in Sharptown district No. 10, of said county.

A bill entitled an Act regulating fences in Lake's, Straight's, and Drawbridge districts, of Dorchester county.
