REPORT.

The Committee appointed to make needful and proper regulations for holding a Joint Session of the Assembly at the delivery of Mr. Wallis' Eulogy on the late George Peabody, have the honor to report the following order, and to recommend the adoption of the same by this House :

Ordered, That at the usual hour of adjournment on this day, Friday, February 26, the House of Delegates shall take a recess until 7½ o'clock, P. M.

During the recess the doors shall be closed to all persons other than members.

Immediately upon re-assembling, at 7½ o'clock, P. M., the Senate shall be invited into Joint Session, in the Hall of the House of Delegates.

And during the Joint Session the doors shall be closed to all persons not holding tickets issued by the Committee of Arrangements.
