The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Frederick and Pennsylvania Line Railroad Company to build a railroad from Frederick city, the terminus of the road, which it is authorized under its charter to build through Frederick and Montgomery counties to the boundary of the District of Columbia, so as to make a distinct connection with the city of Washington,
