

The bill entitled an Act to provide for maintaining and keeping in repair the public roads of Howard county; and to repeal the Act passed at January session, 1868, chapter 358, entitled an Act to provide for the repairs of the public roads of Howard county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal the 7th and 8th sections of an Act to incorporate the Baltimore Permanent Building and Land Society, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter three hundred and fifty-eight,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article first, of Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany county, relating to fees of the County Surveyor,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act for the better protection of game in Baltimore and Carroll counties,

Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to change the jurisdiction of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore city, and reapportion and enlarge the jurisdiction of Baltimore City Court, the Superior Court of Baltimore City, and the Court of Common Pleas; as provided by section 39, of Article 4, of the Constitution,

Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to remove the disabilities of all persons which have been incurred under the 41st section of Article third of the Constitution, and to restore them to the full privileges of citizens.

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 130, of Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," sub-title "Trustees," and to re-enact the same with amendments,
