AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In section 2, line 36 of the printed bill, after the word "Company," insert: And also the benefits and advantages to accrue to the owner or owners by the construction of the said road as a set-off to the said damages, but only in extinguishment of the claim for damages, and not for the actual value of the land or other material taken, and after having made a fair and just off-set of the advantages and disadvantages arising from the construction of said railroad, they shall estimate and determine what amount of damages has been, or may be, sustained by the said owner or owners respectively.

In section 2, line 49 of the printed bill, after the word "prescribed," insert these words: the cost of such second inquisition to be in the discretion of the Court.

In section 3, line 5 of the printed bill, after the words "the sum of," strike out "one" and insert three.

In section 3, line 10 of the printed bill, insert before the words "fifty," the words: one hundred and.

The amendments were then severally read and adopted,
