A bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, at their next annual levy, to levy on the taxable property in said county a sum of money to be applied to the founding and support of schools for colored children in said county.

Mr. Sword, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled a supplement to an Act entitled an Act to authorize the Franklin Railroad Company, incorporated by the State of Pennsylvania, to extend their works within the limits of the State of Maryland, passed at December session, 1836, chapter 76, repealing so much of the first section of said Act as empowers said Railroad Company to connect with the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal at or near Williamsport, and empowering said Franklin Railroad Company to connect with said canal at Williamsport.
