sheep in Queen Anne's, Dorchester, Wicomico and Somerset counties, and for reimbursing owners of sheep for damages sustained by them in the killing or injuring of sheep by dogs,

The bill entitled an Act to extend the corporate powers of the Cumberland and Somerset Turnpike Road Company, incorporated by the Act of 1841, chapter 60, and the supplement thereto, passed by the Act of 1842, chapter 96, until the year 1900.

Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
