Mr. Seibert, Chairman of a Select Committee, (the rules being suspended,) reported unfavorably,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed at December

session, in the year A. D., 1832.

The unfavorable report was adopted.

Mr. Baldwin, of Harford, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the appointment of an additional Justice of the Peace in district No. 2, (Hall's Cross Roads,) in Harford county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Neill, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported fa-

vorably,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to enlarge the powers of the County Commissioners of Washington county, under Article twenty-one, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington County," under the head of "County Commissioners," by adding thereto the following sections.
