Sec. 10. He shall demand and collect from all vessels, except such as are ladened with tobacco, lying at any of the State wharves, the same rates and charges collected by the City of Baltimore, as provided by the Baltimore city Code, sub-title "Harbor and Harbor Masters," sub-title "Wharves," section 31.
