

NIGHT SESSION.

WEDNESDAY, March 16, 7½ o'clock, P. M.

The House met.

On motion of Mr. Shipley, (the rules being suspended,)

The House proceeded to the consideration of the Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the twentieth section of the Act of 1866, chapter 43, entitled an Act to incorporate the President and Directors of the Baltimore and Pikesville Railroad Company, of Baltimore, and enact a substitute therefor.
